11. Elected/Appointed Officials Comments/Concerns

Christensen stated that on February 13th the number six Burkett Mills gate was successfully opened and closed. He said that it was very interesting and it was the first time that he was able to get that close to the mechanism. He took lots of pictures. He stated that it's a good thing to know that it can be operated if something needs to be replaced. It hasn't been opened for fifteen or twenty years.

Crosby stated that he noticed the other night while at a meeting at the Town Hall that it is very dark at the entrance way to the parking lot making it difficult for people to see. The lights that are currently on the front of the Town Hall do not project out far enough. He also pointed out that there was

no light on the flag. Wheeler stated that there is but it is blown right now. He has replaced it a couple times but believes the seal to the light is broke and the light needs to be replaced.

The Board discussed options for lighting in the parking lot.

Perry let the Board know that for the first year of collecting permit fees the Town made \$12,266.78. This was from the 82 permits that Griffin did throughout the year of 2011. Perry stated that there were seventeen septic inspections done in 2011 bringing in \$850.

She shared a little more information from 2011. She stated that there were twelve births and seven deaths in the Town of Barrington. There were one hundred ten pages of minutes and one hundred sixty six resolutions. Perry stated that the abstracts will look a little different this year and she has also changed the format of the minutes a little bit.

Perry let the Board know that John Griffin had his paperwork ready to be filed with her for his standard workday resolution. The paperwork should be ready for the next Town Board meeting.

Christensen suggested holding the Penn Yan Fire Contract bill until they talk to Supervisor Wright. Olney agreed. Christensen will call Wright.
