He stated that then he would know when people are doing things such as putting in a basement or septic.

Griffin stated that he would put on the permit application that before any digging is started the applicant needs to contact the Highway Superintendent along with his phone number.

Griffin said it would be a good idea to put signs at both ends of the road on Lower Lake Road stating that there is no construction allowed in right of way or no blocking the right of way.
