

Special Meeting, Town of Barrington, October 4<sup>th</sup>, 2016

A special meeting of the Town of Barrington, County of Yates and State of New York was held at the Town Hall located at 4424 Bath Road on October 4<sup>th</sup>, 2016.

Supervisor Warren called the meeting to order at 12:00 pm.

The Board discussed having Quackenbush cover the Code Enforcement duties until a replacement is found. Quackenbush really didn't want the duties. He stated that is he was to take it he would have to ask for \$2,000 per month and be paid for mileage.

Quackenbush stated that last January or February he did some filling in for John Griffin after Griffin's surgery but never got paid for it. Warren asked who he sent the bill to. Quackenbush stated that he sent it to Griffin. Clerk Perry stated that is was never given to her to submit to the Board. Warren asked if he still had a copy of the bill. Quackenbush said that he did. Perry stated that he could even fax it to the Town.

Quackenbush stated that he believes the Town would be better off finding someone else to do the work.

Resident Robert "Bob" Dunlap of 811 East Lake Rd. stated that he has had several issues that he has been trying to address with John Griffin. He stated he has been waiting for a septic inspection. He also had questions regarding a new neighbor putting a fence right down the middle of the yard. He is right within six feet of the high water mark. He also put in Jet Ski docks that go right in front of his beach. It goes ten feet into his beach. The white fence has blocked his view of the lake. He was never notified of these proposed changes. He stated that John Griffin stated that he would talk to him. Dunlap stated that he would really like to talk to the gentleman that bought the home and talk to him, but he doesn't even know who the new owner is. Warren stated that he could find out who the new owner is. Dunlap left his phone number.

Clerk Perry asked that next time the Town Board don't plan a meeting while she is open. She can not be fully present to take minutes and run her office at the same time.

A motion to go into executive session at 12:20 pm was made by Castner and seconded by Warren.

5. Since the Olney Place will be closing for the season no more inspections will be required for the rest of the year.
