Kuehn also passed out and went over a resolution regarding support for a consolidated funding grant application and cost sharing of grant writer/consultant fee for a county-wide water infrastructure study.

Resolution 2018-96 to support for a consolidated funding grant application and cost sharing of grant writer/consultant fee for a county-wide water infrastructure study

WHEREAS, the Town of Barrington supports efforts to provide clean drinking water to as many of its residents as is practicable and to support the mutually-beneficial efforts of the Town and Villages in to relation to economic and tourism growth, and

WHEREAS, a County-wide water infrastructure study is a candidate for a NYS Consolidated Funding Application Grant, and

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WHEREAS, Yates County has agreed to sponsor a CFA Grant application, and

WHEREAS, in order to submit the 2018 CFA Grant application for a County-wide water infrastructure study, the County requires the assistance of a consultant with expertise to prepare the submission materials, and

WHEREAS, Municipal Solutions located at 62 Main Street, Leroy, NY 14482, will assist the County in the preparation of the grant application in conjunction with Larsen Engineering as sub-consultant, for a total fee not to exceed \$4,500, and

WHEREAS, Yates County has agreed to fund 50% of the cost of the consultant, with the remaining 50% to be shared equally amongst the participating municipalities, and

WHEREAS, the fees incurred for the consultant shall not exceed \$4,500 and the Towns and Villages have agreed to share the cost of this fee through a mutually-agreed amount and the County shall provide the matching grant funding for the study itself,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Barrington support the submission of a CFA Grant Application by Yates Count for a County-wide water infrastructure study, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town of Barrington agrees to fund its portion of the consultant engaged by Yates County, and be it further

RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be give the Town/Village Clerk, the Yates County Clerk and the Town/Village Attorney.
