Superintendent Wheeler stated that CHIPS is being reduced by 20% starting this year. The Town will be down approximately \$42,000. He believes that he can try to make up for the loss. He stated that there is \$20,000 in the small equipment account that he wanted to buy a new brush hog and a couple other things but that can wait and be worked on next year.

Wheeler shared that the Highway Department has spread a lot of gravel this year; 7,500 tons on VanGordon Road and 2,200 on Pre Emption.
