Steve Delahunty owns property on East Lake Road and would like to cut the guardrail along the road along his property for easier access to the lake. The Board has concerns with the safety if he were to do so. After much discussion the Board stated that they would suggest he start with getting an engineer. They would want a sign-off regarding liability and would have many stipulations if it is approved.

Wheeler was reluctant to give permission because if he is allowed to cut this guardrail then many others will want to do the same. He stated that he would want an engineered plan, a letter of hold harmless and it can't cost the town any money. It also needs to be reviewed by the Town attorney. Jesse Jayne will be the point of contact for Delahunty.

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Jesse Jayne gave a legislative update. He stated that there was a big turnout regarding the Constitutional County adoption. 50 people attended and 49 were against the adoption.

The next meeting will be a budget workshop on September 20th at 6:00 pm. The next regular meeting will be October 25th.
