An extension to the State of Emergency is hereby declared in the Town of Barrington, effective at 5:00 pm on Friday, April 17, 2020.

This State of Emergency has been declared due to Coronavirus-19 (COVID-19), which the World Health Organization has designated as a worldwide pandemic.

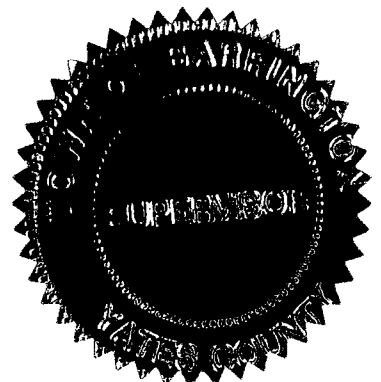
This State of Emergency will remain in effect for thirty (30) days or until rescinded or renewed by a subsequent order.

As the Chief Elected Official of the Town of Barrington, I, Steven Perry, Supervisor of the Town of Barrington, exercise the authority given me under Article 2-B, Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, for the purpose of procuring goods and services, and to render all required and available assistance to municipalities and school districts that is vital to the security, well-being, health and safety of the citizens of Yates County.

I hereby direct all departments and agencies of the Town of Barrington to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure, and provide emergency assistance deemed necessary.
