Town of Barrington Permit to Push Under Road

The Town of Barrington Highway Department requires a permit to push under any Town road.

- 1. The push must be at least five (5) feet below the shoulder of the road
- 2. All excavation work will be done the minimum of five (5) feet from the edge of the blacktop and all materials must be removed once work has ceased.
- 3. All back fill will be done with screen gravel and tamped every six (6) inches
- 4. The Contractor will be responsible for any settling of the excavation site within one year of completion.
- 5. Sleeve will be schedule forty (40) at a minimum
- 6. Contractor must have all required signs in place while work is in progress
- 7. Tracer wire will be put in sleeve and ran to area as needed for future use
- 8. A detailed map will be filed with the Barrington Town Clerk
- 9. Contractor will notify the Barrington Highway Superintendent and Code Enforcement Officer forty eight (48) hours in advance of commencing any work
- 10. Contractor will not stop, change or alter the flow of traffic at anytime
- 11. Contractor is responsible for all damage that occurs to the road
