6. Code Enforcement Report

Jesse Jayne shared that he has been very busy. He sent three letters to residents that need to clean-up their properties. He stated that he has six fire inspections coming up. There are thirteen total businesses in the Town that require inspections.

Jayne stated that the other Towns charge for fire inspections. He suggested that the Board think about setting a fee for the inspections and require that it be done annually. The State requires it to be done every three years.

He further shared that people are still complaining about the concrete business parking all their concrete trucks at their personal residence on Chubb Hollow instead of at the business. Jayne asked for authorization to contact the Town Attorney for guidance. Yarrington agreed.

7. Supervisor’s Comments/Concerns

Yarrington stated that clean-up day was the slowest he has seen it since he has participated in the event, however there was a lot of scrap metal.

8. Public Comments/Concerns

Mike Gow stated that the annual clean-up day is a great service to the Town residents. He also stated that the paving job on East Lake Road looks great.

Jayne gave a legislature update. He stated that the total assessments increased 25.1% for the Town of Barrington. The Town of Milo has an increase of only .4%. He stated that he would like to see the assessments be done by the County for some kind of consistency.
